Top 9 finishes scored – High Point scoring as follows:

Each boat gets 5 points for checking in at the start plus 1 point for each boat they beat in a buoy race.

In the Summerset coastal race, And the Charlotte Harbor Charity distance race each boat gets 10 points for checking in at the start, plus 1.25 points for each boat they beat

In the Boca Grande to Key West race, and in the Key West to Naples race, each boat gets 10 points for checking in at the start plus 2 points for each boat they beat

Boats receiving a DNF or OCS in any race receive their check in points only.

Boats receiving a DNS or DNC in any race receive no points.

Trophies awarded based on number of qualifying boats. 1st for up to 3 boats: 1, 2nd for 3-5 boats: 1, 2, 3rd for 5-7 boats: 1,2,3,4th for 7 or more qualifiers in each division.

Each boat competing must have, or obtain, a current, valid WFLPHRF rating certificate within 30 days of the event to be scored for the event. Boats without current, valid ratings within 30 days of the event will lose their scores.

There is no cost to enter the series but each boat must register by visiting the BOTY page of the West Florida PHRF official website and clicking on the "register" button to declare the series and division they are entering.

Boats must enter each regatta individually, following the rules of entry for each host club's event.
